## CHANGE – LOOKING AT A NEW PATH

On May 21, 2023, the Schoeneck congregation entered a time of change, a change in the spiritual and administrative leadership as our pastors were called to serve another Moravian congregation. Since that time, the Board of Elders and the Board of Trustees have assumed the responsibility for the spiritual and administrative duties of our church, attempting to keep things going without any undue stress on the congregation. This change challenged each board member to step out of their comfort zone to help direct the church through this unknown period as leading worship, helping with administrative duties or other tasks that required assistance. Despite all the challenges we have faced, we have been able to maintain our worship schedule every Sunday, including livestream to those members unable to attend in person, host a province-wide Youth Rally, renovate our beloved church organ without incurring debt and schedule classes for new members to join our congregation. The Board of Elders and the Board of Trustees could not have accomplished this without the support and encouragement from the congregation and we are eternally grateful!

Now, we step into another change for the congregation...calling a new pastor. The 'call process' is a well-orchestrated, albeit at times lengthy, procedure to identify the correct person as our next spiritual leader. However, this process requires discernment and listening to God's small voice to select the person He has already selected to come to Schoeneck. Many of you have wondered why it seems to have taken so long! Let's remember how busy we were last year with planning for the Youth Rally, organ renovation and rededication followed closely by Christmas, all activities that were important to the life of Schoeneck. One small caveat that caused a slight delay was the request by the Eastern District Executive Board (EDEB) to interview the congregation on what we wanted in a pastor. This was something we needed to do since the questionnaire during the summer of 2023 yielded some discrepancies that needed to be addressed. Once it was realized the discrepancies were more prevalent shortly after the departure of our former pastors and had since 'cooled down', the call process began in earnest and proceeded at a typical pace. In mid-April, the Joint Board was informed that Rev. Ian Edwards had accepted the call to become the next full-time pastor of Schoeneck Moravian Church! The 11-month gap without a full-time pastor was part of God's plan for Schoeneck as it prepared our congregation for a new path and a new adventure. God's timing is always perfect!

Most of the congregation is aware that Brenda and I have moved away from Nazareth to be closer to our grandchildren. The decision to move is somewhat easy....actually moving away from family and friends is not so easy!! All of us need to realize that God has a plan for your life. Change can be hard but when you listen to God and trust what He has for planned for you, the change will not be so difficult. Lamentations 3:25 perfectly states what happens when we trust in God's timing; "The Lord is good to those whose hope is in him, to the one who seeks him." Learn to listen to that 'small voice' inside. It is God whispering what He wants us to do, according to the plan he has established.

All of us have been experiencing change over the past few weeks or months. Whether it is searching for a new pastor, dealing with an illness or a family member with an illness, moving away from family and friends or something else, God knows and understands what we need to get through your season of change. Continue to go to Him in prayer, expressing your joys and concerns and He will guide your path. All you need to do is ask and God will provide.

## ELDERS PERSPECTIVE

Now that the announcement of a new pastor was made, I want to give you a brief understanding what the Joint Board (JB) experienced as part of the call process. As you know, the call process is the procedure used by the Moravian Church to prayerfully consider the names brought forth by the Eastern District Executive Board (EDEB) when a pastoral opening occurs in a church. This process contained a lot of prayer and discernment to determine the best person to serve a congregation.

Briefly, the call process is a series of meetings that begins with the rules and regulations of the process and followed by a discussion of the names the EDEB believes could serve as the pastor of the church. During the entire process, regardless of the number of meetings required, all JB members are reminded of the silence required as part of this process since the pastors identified by the EDEB do not know they are being considered for a call. Once the identified person is 'called', a dialogue occurs between the person and the JB. At the conclusion of the dialogue, a 2/3 majority vote of the JB is needed to continue with the candidate. The voting result is communicated to the candidate who has the ability to accept or decline the call. For Schoeneck, Pastor Ian Edwards accepted to call to be our next full-time pastor!

During the entire call process, the Joint Board, as elected members to represent the congregation, was continually in prayer to discern the best person to serve as our pastor as stated in James 1:5 *"If any of you lack wisdom, let them ask God, who gives generously to all without reproach, and it will be given."* All announcements made during the time without a pastor were done to make sure the congregation knew the JB was diligently working to find a full-time pastor. All the prayers of the congregation were felt by all JB members. God led us to call Pastor Ian Edwards, now it's up to all of us to move forward to do God's work!
